# Student competes for a bursary

*Ruimsig* — Maragon's Natalia Do Rosario Dos Santos has been selected as one of the five Gauteng students who will compete in the finals of the International Bursary Bootcamp Competition.

The finalists will compete for a life-changing R160 000 bursary in a competition that will take place from 10 to 15 July.

Natalia and the other four finalists were chosen from among 30 matric students from all over Gauteng, Mpumalanga, Free State and Limpopo, all of whom were invited to gather at the International Hotel School's Sandton Campus for the first of this year's semifinals.

When asked how she felt about being chosen as one of the five finalists, Natalia said she was, "Extremely excited!" and that winning the bursary would be "an accomplishment and a boost for my fu-

ture".

The International Hotel School's Johannesburg managing principal, Miems Nel says, "The finalists will stay at the Indaba Hotel and over their five-day Bootcamp they will be coached and assessed by their 'Drill Sergeants' who are the hotel's very own heads of departments and general manager.

"Your ability and attitude with every task faced will determine whether you will walk away with the R160 000 bursary to the International Hotel School."

It was one of Natalia's two brothers who pushed her to enter the competition.

"My brother said I have the potential and that I should give it a try." The 18-year-old's favourite aspect of the hotel industry is house keeping and she plans on working in the best hotels in our country.
