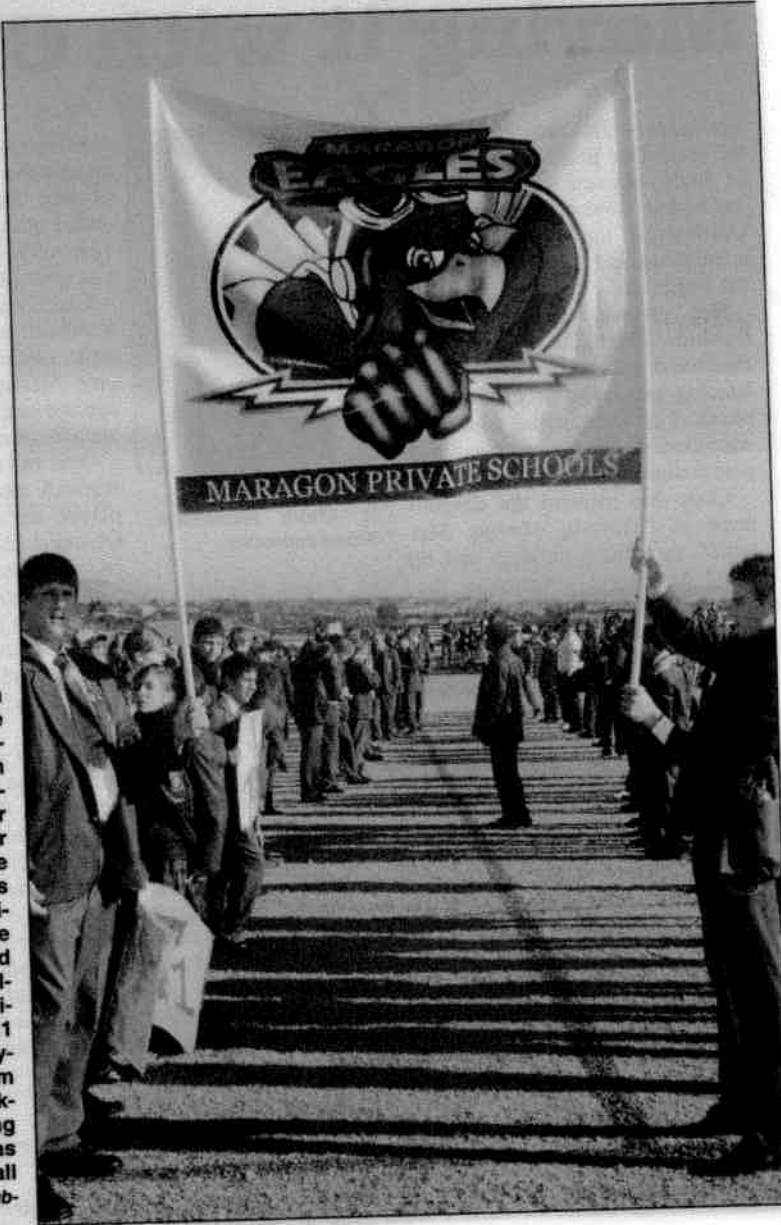


Maragon rugby making progress
