Ruimsig — Cameron Wills, the head boy of Maragon Primary School, received a gold medal at the Eskom Science Expo, which took place in July. He went through to the second round of judging at St Stithians Boys College.

He was then selected to go through to the nationals, which will be held over three days in October.

Cameron's project was entitled *Lupus the Silent Killer*, and it was about the auto-immune disease called systemic *lupus erythematosus*.

He carried out specific tests and experiments with his case study patient, and researched six environmental factors that are known to influence lupus flares.

Cameron was the only individual from Maragon to get through to the nationals, but there are two other groups that made it through from Grade 7 too, namely Mira DeCrama and Christopher Efginio's group and Tristan Geerlings and Jean André Cilliers' group.

They all worked very hard on their various projects.
